WHO IS ST TERESA OF AVILA?



St. Teresa of Avila, also known as St. Teresa of Jesus, was a prominent Spanish mystic, Carmelite nun, and a Doctor of the Church. She was born on March 28, 1515, in Gotarrendura, a small town in the province of Ávila, Spain. St. Teresa lived during the tumultuous period of the Spanish Reformation and Counter-Reformation.

At a young age, she displayed a deep devotion to the Catholic faith and felt drawn to a life of prayer and contemplation. In 1535, she entered the Carmelite Monastery of the Incarnation in Ávila. St. Teresa of Avila is celebrated as one of the greatest mystics and spiritual writers in the history of Christianity. Her feast day is observed on October 15th.

Each day read the topic and look at the image. Spent 5 minutes allowing yourself to be in this thought. Don't analyse or critic the meditation, if you can.

Then read the question and reflect on the question for another 5 minutes.

The 57 days will take you through the entirety of the Interior Castle. Think of it as an inner pilgrimage. At times it will be difficult, but don't despair. Keep going if you can. I look forward to seeing you on the other side.
